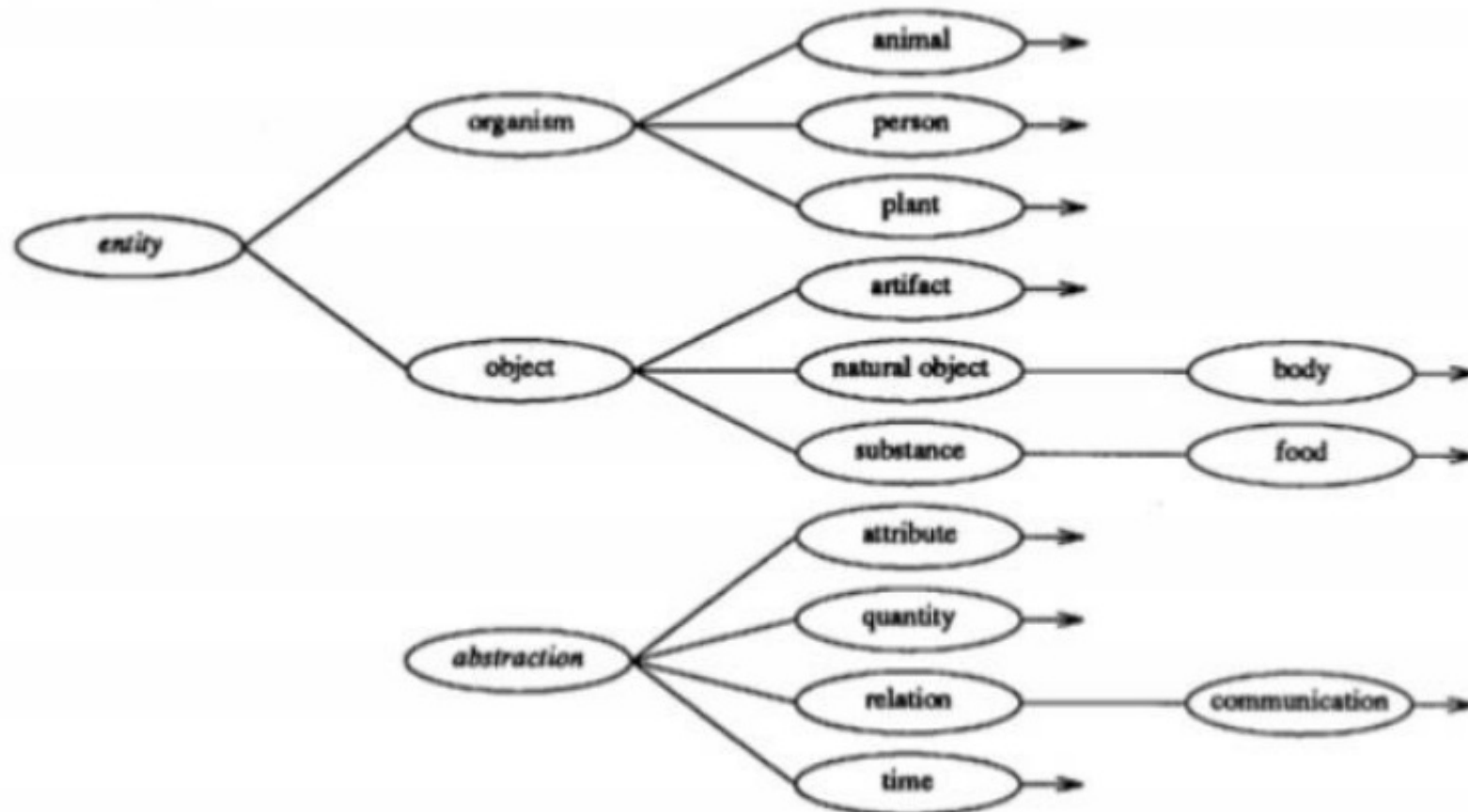

Usando WordNet (2)

Como saben, **WordNet** ofrece una taxonomía de conceptos generales. La estructuración de ésta se sustenta en una jerarquía léxica como la siguiente:



Usando WordNet (3)

¿Cómo podemos establecer cuáles son los rasgos que caracterizan a un conjunto? Básicamente, tenemos 3 relaciones para esto:

Relation	Definition	Example
Hypernym	From concepts to superordinates	<i>breakfast</i> → <i>meal</i>
Hyponym	From concepts to subtypes	<i>meal</i> → <i>lunch</i>
Has-Member	From groups to their members	<i>faculty</i> → <i>professor</i>
Member-Of	From members to their groups	<i>copilot</i> → <i>crew</i>
Has-Part	From wholes to parts	<i>table</i> → <i>leg</i>
Part-Of	From parts to wholes	<i>course</i> → <i>meal</i>
Antonym	Opposites	<i>leader</i> → <i>follower</i>

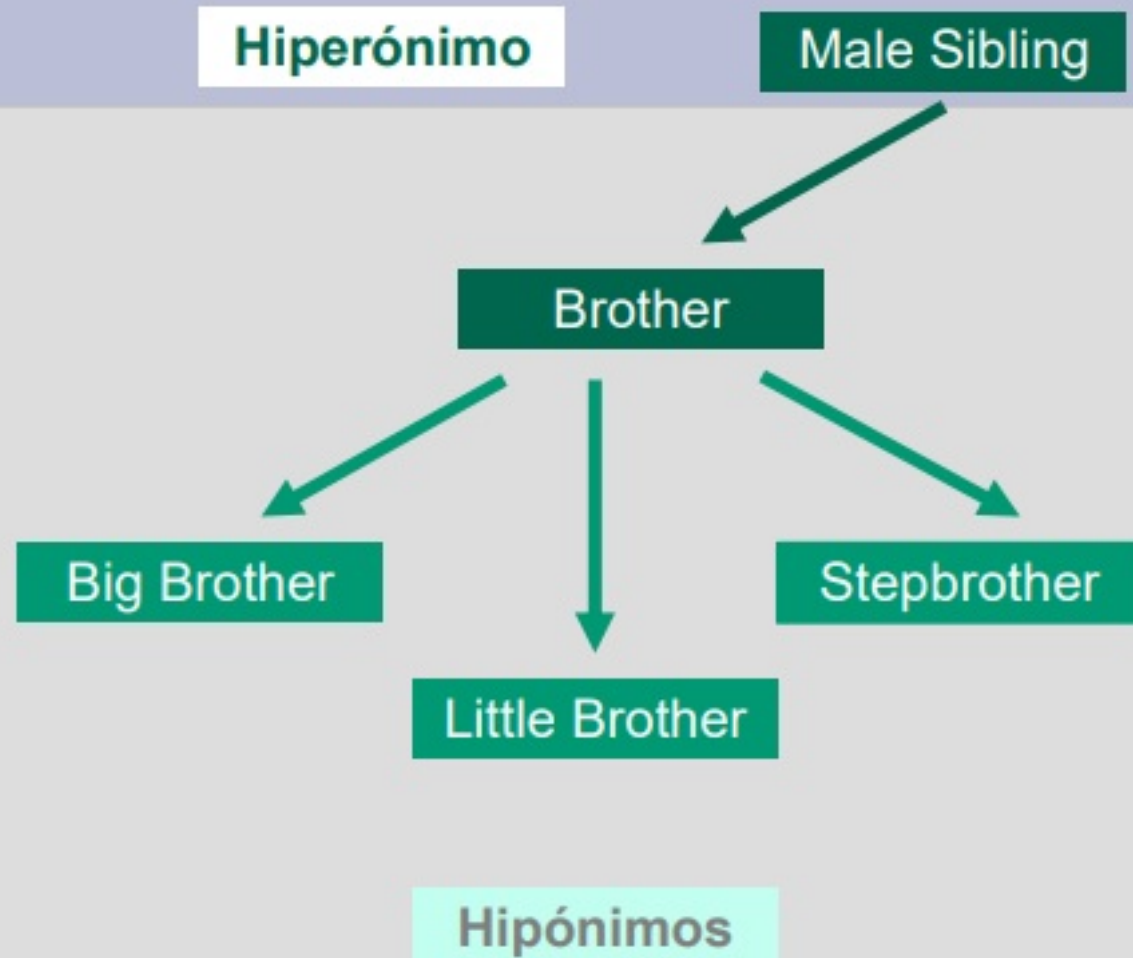
