

Usando WordNet (1)


Para esta sesión, vamos a hacer una tarea sencilla para entender mejor cómo funcionan las **relaciones léxicas** que se dan entre **lexemas** (o **palabras**). Usaremos entonces **WordNet**, un **lexicón electrónico** del que ya hemos visto algunas cosas.

Usando WordNet (2)

Como saben, **WorNet** ofrece una taxonomía de conceptos generales. La estructuración de ésta se sustenta en una jerarquía léxica como la siguiente:



Usando WordNet (3)

¿Cómo podemos establecer cuáles son los rasgos que caracterizan a un conjunto? Básicamente, tenemos 3 relaciones para esto:

Relation	Definition	Example
Hypernym	From concepts to superordinates	$breakfast \rightarrow meal$
Hyponym	From concepts to subtypes	$meal \rightarrow lunch$
Has-Member	From groups to their members	faculty → professor
Member-Of	From members to their groups	$copilot \rightarrow crew$
Has-Part	From wholes to parts	$table \rightarrow leg$
Part-Of	From parts to wholes	$course \rightarrow meal$
Antonym	Opposites	$leader \rightarrow follower$


